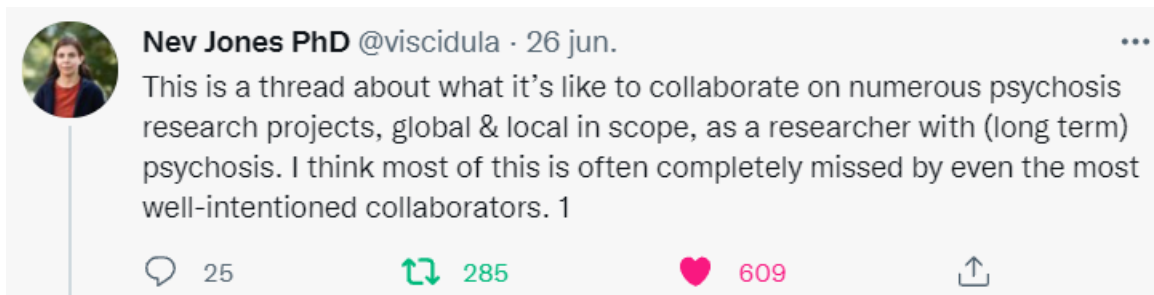


Online dialogue Experts 'with' Experience
